Program Description:

The Air Conditioning Repair Specialist certificate program prepares students for positions in the maintenance and repair of air conditioning systems. A combination of theory and practical application provides for the necessary skills to support industry requirements. Graduates may find entry-level employment as air conditioning repair persons or in related occupations. Salaries in this occupation are estimated to range from \$36,170 - \$51,390 per year (BLS.gov May 2022).
