

General Studies AS Degree/Sociology (AIG3)- 62 Credit Hours

Program Description:

The Associate of Science Degree in General Studies provides an opportunity for Kyle Taylor, Instructor students to earn specific occupational and general education credits in math, humanities, social sciences, and natural sciences that can transfer toward a four-year degree. The degree requires completion of 62 semester credit hours (41 hours of general education requirements and a minimum of 21 hours of specific occupational courses). The **Sociology** specialization prepares students to analyze human society and social behavior by examining the groups and social institutions that people form, as well as various social, religious, political, and business organizations. This specialization will be offered primarily online. Graduates may pursue entry-level careers as social service workers, court advocates, case managers, or community outreach specialists, or may choose to continue toward a bachelor's degree in sociology.
