Program Specific

- Applicant must be certified in radiography, nuclear medicine, or radiation therapy by the American Registry of Radiologic Technologists (ARRT).
- A copy of the front and back of the ARRT certification card must be submitted.
- Applicants who are recent graduates of an accredited radiologic technology program may request a waiver of this requirement, but must submit a copy of their ARRT certification card prior to start of the program.
