The Pharmacy Technology diploma program is designed to enable the student to acquire the knowledge, skills and attitudes for employment within a pharmacy. Program graduates will be able to perform a variety of technical duties related to preparing and dispensing drugs in accordance with standard procedures and laws under the supervision of a registered pharmacist. A variety of clinical experiences is designed to integrate theory and practice. Graduates may find entry-level employment in hospitals, retail pharmacies, managed care (health insurance and pharmacy benefit managers), nuclear pharmacy, and long-term care facilities. Starting salary \$34,153.
