



## Networking Specialist Diploma (NS14)- 54 Credit Hours

**Program Description:**

The Networking Specialist associate diploma program is a sequence of courses designed to provide students with an understanding of the concepts, principles, and techniques required in computer information processing. Graduates are to be competent in the general areas of humanities or fine arts, social or behavioral sciences, and natural sciences or mathematics, as well as in the technical areas of computer terminology and concepts, program design and development, and computer networking. Graduates may find employment in network installation and maintenance, networking administration, network operating systems support, and hardware repair/maintenance. Starting salaries are approximately \$38,000 per year.
