

EMS - FF I I: Firefighter I TCC (replaces FFII: Firefighter I in the Quarter System)

The Firefighter I certificate program is conducted in cooperation with the Georgia Fire Academy and Georgia Firefighter Standards and Training to ensure graduates have the skills, knowledge, and credentials to serve as firefighters in paid and volunteer fire departments. Graduates will be tested and certified at the National Professional Qualifications level.

Career Opportunities

Graduates of the program are prepared for entry-level positions with fire departments and other agencies requiring the services of a trained firefighter for fire safety purposes.
