Turn-it-in

WGTC uses Turn-it-in as plagiarism prevention resource and makes it available in all online courses. Any written work submitted in online courses could be checked for originality through Turn-it-in. WGTC takes violations of academic integrity seriously. As a result, procedures have been developed on how academic dishonesty/plagiarism is to be handled. In addition to the information included in Student Catalog and Student handbook, the faculty may provide more specific information on their course syllabi so students will know exactly what is expected of them in each online course.

How turn-it-in works?

The electronic version of the student written work is submitted to Turn-it-in which in return produces originality report. This report shows the student and faculty the results of comparison of the submitted work and the content of the web, and turn-it-in database. When plagiarism is suspected, each faculty follow the guidelines stated on their course syllabi.
