Homecoming Court Requirements

To have your application taken into consideration you must meet the following prerequisites and agree to the following rules listed below.

1. Applicant must be a WGTC currently enrolled student in good standing (cannot be an adult education student or dual enrolled student)
2. Applicant must be able to attend a meeting prior to the Week of Homecoming.
3. Applicant must be able to attend the Homecoming Game on Saturday, October 29 at Central High School.
4. Applicant must provide a brief bio with one (1) photo attached (Bio should outline any WGTC campus involvement and why you wish to be king/queen). Do not include additional photographs.

Campaigning Rules

Campaigning is strongly encouraged. Campaigning includes, but not limited to, the distribution of flyers, posters, buttons, and/or any other materials that portray a candidate's image, name, qualifications, and desire to be King/Queen. Candidates must follow campaigning guidelines as outline in this packet.

1. Campaigning is not allowed prior to notification. All materials must be removed on Monday, October 31, 2011 by 5:00
2. Materials used to campaign must not exceed \$25 per candidate. Receipts and a budget summary may be requested by the Homecoming Committee if a candidate is suspected of violating this rule.
3. All materials posted must follow all WGTC policies given by the Office of Student Activities. In addition, the authorities in the building you wish to post must approve all campaigning materials.
4. Campaigning is prohibited in class or in any campus computer lab.
5. With credible evidence, any candidate who is found guilty of tampering with other candidates campaigning materials will be disqualified.
6. Any complaints regarding violations of campaign rules should be submitted in writing to the Homecoming Chairperson within 24 hours of offense. All decisions regarding violations are final.
7. Candidates are not allowed to run as a pair. Campaigning will only be conducted on an individual basis. Candidates found running together will result in disqualification.
