

WGTC CLT Program Outcomes and Systematic Assessment

The CLT Program at West Georgia Technical College will:

- 85% of students admitted to the CLT program will complete the program as technically competent individuals ready to enter the laboratory workforce.
- Graduates will take the AMT or ASCP BOR national certification exam with a pass rate at or above the national average of 75%.
- Within six month of graduation, 95% of graduates seeking employment in the laboratory field will be employed.
- Employers and graduates returning surveys will report 85% satisfaction with educational preparation.
