DO I QUALIFY?

Recipients must be:

- Currently receiving CAPS (apply at www.Gateway.ga.gov)
- A single mother
- Attending a HOPE-eligible college or university in Georgia.

Applicants must provide a copy of their CAPS Scholarship to Nana Grants for verification purposes.
