three-story brick and steel structure, will house the enrollment center, student center, bookstore and library. Labs include those for paramedicine, certified nursing assistant, cosmetology, chemistry, criminal justice, engineering and early childhood development programs. General classrooms and computer labs will be scattered throughout.

The second building is a large, single-story technical education building of almost 62,000 square feet housing labs for diesel equipment technology, welding, carpentry, manufacturing, industrial systems and machine tool programs.






