New Carroll Campus plans released



three-story brick and steel structure, will house the enrollment center, student center, bookstore and library. Labs include those for paramedicine, certified nursing assistant, cosmetology, chemistry, criminal justice, engineering and early childhood development programs. General classrooms and computer labs will be scattered throughout.

The first official architectural renderings of West Georgia Technical College's new Carroll Campus show two large buildings planned for the Buffalo Creek Technology Park on the Carrollton Bypass.

"This campus will certainly bring Carroll County what it deserves in terms of space, technology and resources," WGTC President Dr. Scott Rule said.

"We are prioritizing classrooms, labs and student spaces to make sure they can be the very best they can be. It is a campus we can all be proud of."

The second building is a large, single-story technical education building of almost 62,000 square feet housing labs for diesel equipment technology, welding, carpentry, plumbing, air conditioning, precision manufacturing, industrial systems and machine tool programs.

The new campus is scheduled to open in 2022 and replace the College's 52-year-old campus on Newnan Road. Programs currently offered at the Newnan Road campus will relocate when the new campus opens.

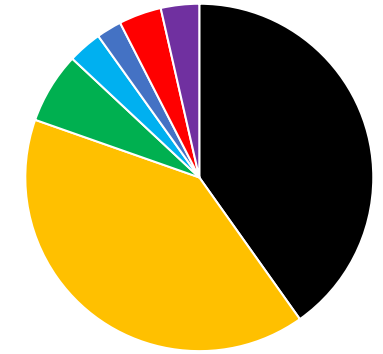

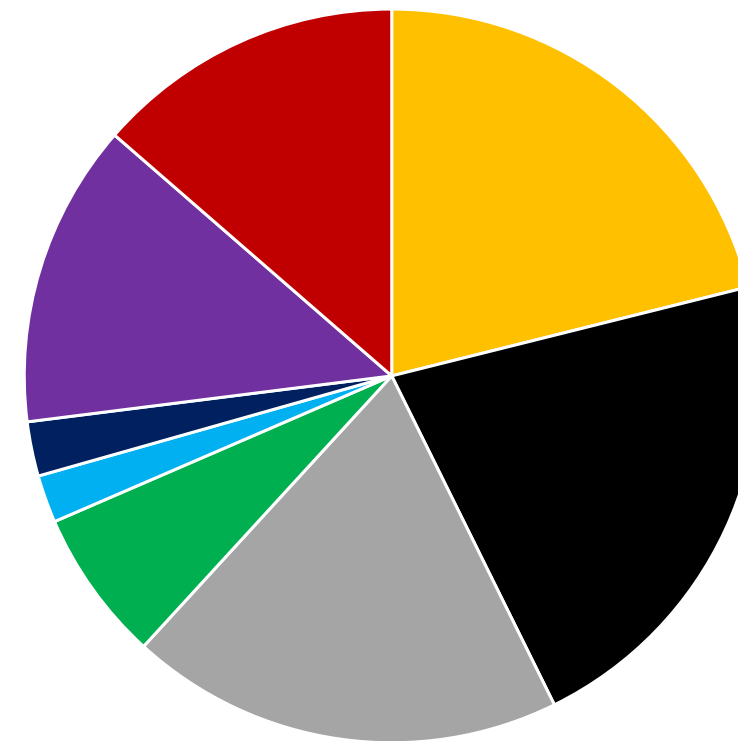
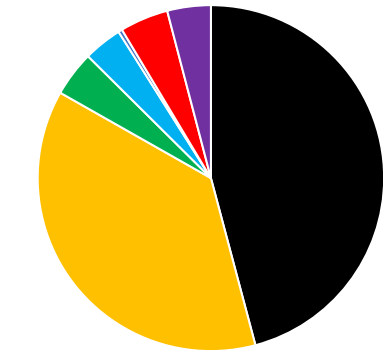
