### Student Financial Obligations

Failure to meet financial obligations to the College may result in the student's automatic withdrawal with no credit for the term. Additionally, such a student may be denied enrollment in subsequent terms. The College will withhold copies of educational records of students who have outstanding debts to the institution. Indebtedness to the College will result in the College seeking to recover those funds via a third-party collection agency.

#### VI. A. 1

After all payment options have been exhausted, students with unpaid fees by the payment deadline must be purged from enrollment records for the term.
