Student Activity Fund

West Georgia Technical College is authorized to establish a Student Activity Fund account and collect fees from students. Without attempting to provide an exhaustive list of purposes for which Student Activity Funds may be used, it is the intent of the department that these funds are used for the benefit of students, and, to a limited extent, the enhancement of the institution, and thus the students, as determined by the Student Activity Fund Committee. The amount of student activity fee charged should approximate the amount required to meet needs as identified by the Student Activity Fund Committee. There should be no material amount available and not committed at the end of each fiscal year. The President shall review year end balances and make appropriate requests to the State Board for any adjustment of the fee.

All purchases from Student Activity Funds must have meeting minutes from the Student Government Association (SGA) approving the purchase.

The Student Government Association (SGA) shall govern and administer the Student Activity Fund Account with the oversight of the College President.
