

WGTC 8.10

Program Suspension/Expulsion

WGTC Adult Education students are expected to abide by the WGTC Student Code of Conduct, and failure to do so can result in suspension or expulsion at the discretion of the Vice President for Adult Education or designee. Additionally, instructors are charged with maintaining a classroom environment that is conducive to learning and may redirect or verbally reprimand students who interfere with this. Students who create ongoing disruptions to the learning environment may receive a written infraction. Students receiving two infractions within a two-week time frame may be subject to suspension at the recommendation of the instructor to the Vice President for Adult Education or designee.

Suspension bars a student from attending classes at any WGTC Adult Education program site for a period of up to 90 days. After the suspension period, students wishing to re-enter the program must request a meeting with the Vice President for Adult Education to discuss their intent. Program re-entry for suspended students is at the discretion of the Vice President for Adult Education.

Expulsion prohibits a student from returning to any WGTC Adult Education program site in perpetuity.

Parents or guardians who have provided permission for under-age students to enroll will receive notification of their children's suspensions or expulsions.
