Program Description:

The Air Conditioning Electrical Technician certificate program prepares students in the air conditioning area of study to acquire competencies in electricity related to installation, service, and maintenance of electrical systems. Graduates may find employment as service technician helpers, in plant maintenance, or in sales. Salaries in this occupation are estimated to range from \$36,170 - \$51,390 per year (BLS.gov May 2022).
