The Air Conditioning Technician Assistant certificate program prepares students in the installation of heating and air conditioning systems. Emphasis is placed on theory and practical application skills necessary for successful employment. Graduates may find entry-level employment as service technician helpers, in plant maintenance, or in sales. Salaries in this occupation 706-756-4565 are estimated to range from \$36,170 - \$51,390 per year (BLS.gov May 2022).
