



Air Conditioning Technician Assistant (AZ31)- 12 Credit Hours

Program Description:

The Air Conditioning Technician Assistant certificate program prepares students to hold positions as technician assistants in the HVACR field. Graduates may find entry-level employment as service technician helpers, in plant maintenance, or in sales. Salaries in this occupation are estimated to range from \$36,170 - \$51,390 per year (BLS.gov May 2022).

Students starting the diploma in the Summer will take General Education courses only. All certificate options are only available during the Fall and Spring semesters. If you miss or fail to complete a course, you will wait until the course is offered again.
