



Automotive Engine Repair Certificate (AE61)- 15 Credit Hours

Program Description:

The Automotive Engine Repair Technician certificate program provides the student with entry-level automotive engine repair skills. Topics include basic shop safety, basic electrical/electronic diagnosis, principles of engine operation, basic engine diagnosis, and basic engine repair procedures. Graduates may find entry-level employment as technician apprentices or technician's helpers with automotive repair and maintenance shops, automobile dealers, or retailers and wholesalers of automotive parts, accessories, and supplies. Salaries in this occupation are estimated to range from \$29,270 - \$46,970 per year (BLS.gov May 2022).
