Program Description:

The CNC Technology diploma program is a sequence of courses that prepares students for careers in the CNC technology field. Learning opportunities develop academic, technical, and professional knowledge and skills for job acquisition, retention, and advancement. The program emphasizes a combination of CNC theory and practical application necessary for successful employment. Graduates may find employment as CNC technicians or machine tool technicians or in a related field. Salaries in this occupation are estimated at \$33,470 – \$48,510 per year. (BLS.gov May 2022)
