The Early Childhood Care and Education diploma program is a sequence of courses designed to prepare students for a variety of careers in the field of early childhood education. The program emphasizes a combination of early childhood care and education theory and practical application as well as general core competencies necessary for successful employment. Graduates have qualifications to be employed in early care and education settings. Graduates may find employment as preschool teachers in Head Start, Early Head Start, or private preschools; private household childcare workers; or self-employed childcare providers.
