Program Description:

The Electrical Systems Technology diploma program provides instruction in the Alan Threadgill, Instructor inspection, maintenance, installation, and repair of electrical systems in the residential, commercial, and industrial industries. A combination of theory and practical application is emphasized to develop academic, technical, and professional knowledge and skills. Graduates may find employment with a number of firms both small and large. Local residential/commercial electrical contractors as well as larger manufacturing businesses or industries will continue to have a need for individuals with basic skills in electricity. Program graduates have the qualifications of entry level electricians. Salaries in this occupation are estimated to range from \$37,440 - \$47,200 per year (BLS.gov May 2022).
