

# **Electronics Technology Degree (ET13)- 61 Credit Hours Industrial Electronics Technology Specialization**

## **Program Description:**

The Electronics Technology associate degree program is a sequence of courses designed to prepare students for careers in electronics professions. Learning opportunities develop academic, technical, and professional knowledge and skills required for job acquisition, retention, and advancement. The program emphasizes a combination of electronics technology theory and practical application necessary for successful employment using both manual and computerized electronics systems. Graduates may find employment as specialized industrial or specialized general electronics technicians, assemblers, testers, repairers, and calibrators. Initial salaries are approximately \$47,200 per year. (BLS.gov May 2022)
