*Per the State Board of Cosmetology and Barbers, students are required to complete a minimum of 1500 hours of training and complete all the required lab skill competencies within the program.

To meet the minimum required hours, the WGTC Cosmetology program attendance requirements are as follows: students are only allowed to be absent from each individual Cosmetology or Esthetics class for 1 full day [or the total hours of 1 class period]. Students arriving late for class or leaving early results in a tardy. Once a student has 3 tardies, that will equal 1 absence or if a student has missed the total of their class time in 2 tardies, that will be counted as an absence.

The State Board of Cosmetology and Esthetics has a cap of 4 years for students to gain their license once they complete our program. Due to the time limit that the state has set in place, we also have a 4-year limit for students to complete all the classes within their major or they will have to re-take the entire program. If a student has not completed the program within 2 years, they will be required to complete one (1) full Fall or Spring semester.
