Nature of Duties: The student worker will perform general housekeeping duties such as tool box organization, lab equipment upkeep, prepapring lab for visitors, preparing equipment for testing, and other duties in accordance with the West Georgia Technical College Federal Work Study Handbook.

- Willingness to learn about electrical, HVAC, and maintenance on a basic level, PLC & Software operation
- Willing to stand, lift and move as well as use tools and equipment for entire shift

Salary/Benefits: \$10 per hour; no benefits

Method of Application: Interested candidates must <u>apply online</u> through the <u>Federal Work Study Program</u> section of the WGTC website. Applicants will be contacted by area supervisor for interviews.

Note - Selected candidates must successfully complete a background check to include employment references, criminal history, and verification of employment prior to hire.
