### **Program Description:**

The Associate of Science Degree in General Studies provides an opportunity for<br/>students to earn specific occupational and general education credits in math,<br/>humanities, social sciences, and natural sciences that can transfer toward a<br/>four-year degree. The degree requires completion of 62 semester credit hours<br/>(41 hours of general education requirements and a minimum of 21 hours of<br/>specific occupational courses). The **Biology** specialization provides students<br/>with a foundation in life sciences, mathematics, and lab skills.
