

## Electrical Maintenance Technician (EM81)- 18 Credit Hours

## **Program Description:**

The Electrical Maintenance Technician Technical Certificate of Credit provides instruction in industrial systems electrical inspection, maintenance, service, and repair. Topics include DC and AC fundamentals, motor controls, magnetic starters and braking systems, PLCs, and industrial wiring procedures. Graduates may find entry-level employment as industrial maintenance technicians/electricians. Starting salary for this occupation is estimated to be \$38,900. (BLS.gov May 2022)
