Associate of Applied Science in a Health Discipline at West Georgia Technical College to

Bachelor of Science in Health Science at Northern Kentucky University

General Information

Purpose

This Agreement establishes a partnership between Northern Kentucky University and West Georgia Technical College for the purpose of providing students well-defined and fully integrated pathways from initial postsecondary enrollment to an associate degree from West Georgia Technical College to a baccalaureate degree from Northern Kentucky University.

NKU Degrees/Programs Covered in this Agreement

All academic progression plans in this Agreement apply only to students who successfully complete all requirements and are awarded an associate degree at West Georgia Technical College.

Degrees included in this Agreement are: AAS in Dental Hygiene

AAS in Health Information Management Technology

AAS in Pharmacy Technology

AAS in Medical Laboratory Technology

AAS in Radiologic Technology AAS in Surgical Technology

<u>Provisions for Review, Revision and Catalog of Record Designation</u>

Both parties agree to review this Agreement on an annual basis on or about the release of their respective academic catalogs for the forthcoming academic year, and to make any necessary updates required by curricular changes.

To avoid disadvantaging students at West Georgia Technical College who have formally begun the four year progression outlined in this document, students enrolling at Northern Kentucky University with an earned associate degree from West Georgia Technical College will be permitted to designate their catalog of record up to two years before the year of NKU enrollment, if such designation is to their advantage.

Benefits for Students Provided by Northern Kentucky University

Northern Kentucky University will make the benefits listed below available to students of West Georgia Technical College who have declared their intent to earn the associate degree and subsequently pursue a baccalaureate degree at Northern Kentucky University.

 Access to online or on-campus advising from a professional advisor while enrolled at West Georgia Technical College before entering NKU. • Guidance from NKU faculty and advisors in selection of major and related career opportunities while enrolled at West Georgia Technical College before entering NKU.

Benefits for Students Provided by West Georgia Technical College

West Georgia Technical College will make the benefits listed below available to students at West Georgia Technical College who have declared their intent to earn the associate degree at West Georgia Technical College.

- Access to an orientation program and academic advising from the Advising Center at West Georgia Technical College during the completion of the associate's degree.
- Guidance from West Georgia Technical College faculty and advisors regarding course selection, professional development, career opportunities and transfer expectations.

Additional Partnership Commitments

All parties to this Agreement commit to the following in order to enhance the success of our students:

- Frequent communication at all levels.
- Collaboration in instructional rigor and content to ensure that students are well-prepared for upper division coursework.

Cancellation and Expiration

This Agreement may be cancelled by the chief academic officer of either institution by providing written notice to the other at least one academic semester prior to the effective date of termination.

This Agreement will be considered continuous for five (5) years from the date of signing unless revision or cancellation is requested by either party. Either party may terminate this Agreement at its convenience and without cause, upon sixty (60) calendar days' written notice of intent to terminate. The Agreement will expire after five (5) years unless renewed by agreement of both parties.

Curriculum (AY 2024-2025 Academic Catalog)

Completion of the following curricula will satisfy the requirements under the AY 2024-2025 academic catalogs for the designated Associate of Applied Science degrees at West Georgia Technical College and lead to the Bachelor of Science in Health Science degree at Northern Kentucky University. Admission and degree requirements for each degree are listed on the pathway.

Students who complete an Associate of Science or an Associate of Arts degree from a regionally accredited institution or an institution accredited by an agency recognized by the U.S. Department of Education will be recognized as fulfilling NKU General Education certification requirements. Students who earn an Associate in Applied Science degree or who do not complete an Associate of Arts or Associate of Science degree before transferring must satisfy General Education requirements at NKU on a course-by-course equivalency basis.

Intending to be legally bound, by signing below, each party acknowledges its agreement with the terms and conditions of the Agreement and each signatory represent and warrant that the he/she is authorized to sign on behalf of and to bind his/her party to all of the terms and conditions of this Agreement as of the Effective Date.

TRANSFER PATHWAY GUIDE 2024-2025

Associate of Applied Science in a Health Discipline at West Georgia Technical College to a Bachelor of Science in Health Science at Northern Kentucky University

Overview

Completion of the following curriculum will satisfy the requirements for the chosen Associate of Applied Science (AAS) degree in a Health Discipline at West Georgia Technical College (WGTC) and leads to the Bachelor of Science (BS) in Health Science degree at Northern Kentucky University (NKU).

Degree Requirements for West Georgia Technical College

To earn a degree at West Georgia Technical College, a student must complete a minimum of 60 credit hours and attain a minimum cumulative GPA of 2.0.

Admission Requirements for NKU

Students completing an associate degree with a cumulative GPA of 2.0 or higher will be accepted into NKU. Students wishing to enroll in the Health Science Completer degree must have a minimum college GPA of 2.30. The Degree Completion Track is designed for students who have an earned associate degree in a health discipline looking to complete a bachelor's degree.

This major can be completed online. Courses are offered in seven-week formats. Tuition for online accelerated programs differs from face-to-face tuition. Degree Requirements for NKU

To earn a bachelor's degree at NKU, students must complete a minimum of 120 credit hours with at least 45 credit hours numbered 300 and above. In addition, at least 25% of the credit hours required for the degree and the last 30 credit hours must be completed at NKU. Students must have an overall GPA of 2.0, earn a C or better in major courses, and meet all prerequisites for courses and requirements for the major. An associate of applied science (AAS) degree or equivalent from a regionally accredited institution or an institution accredited by an agency recognized by the U.S. Department of Education serves as an imbedded minor for the program.
