

Paramedicine Accelerated (Fall Start) (PAF1)- 44 Credit Hours

Program Description:

The Paramedicine certificate program prepares students for employment in paramedic positions in today's health services field. The Paramedic Certificate Program provides learning opportunities that introduce, develop, and reinforce adam.watson@westgatech.edu academic and occupational knowledge, skills, and attitudes required for job acquisition, retention, and advancement. The program provides opportunities to upgrade present knowledge and skills from the EMT/EMT-I 1985/AEMT levels to a paramedic level. Successful completion of the program allows the graduate to take the National Registry of Emergency Medical Technicians (NREMT) Paramedic certification examination and apply for Georgia licensure with the State Office of Emergency Medical Service and Trauma (SOEMST) as a paramedic. Criminal background checks and drug screens may be required based on the requirements for participation in clinical experiences. Graduates may seek employment in a variety of settings including fire departments, hospitals, ambulance services, local government, and in several industries. Starting salaries are approximately \$42,000 per year.
