



Phlebotomy Technology Specialist Certificate (PT71)- 17 Credit Hours

Program Description:

The Phlebotomy Technician program educates students to collect blood and process blood and body fluids. Phlebotomy technicians typically work together with clinical laboratory personnel and other healthcare providers in hospitals or other healthcare facilities. Topics covered in this certificate include human anatomy, anatomical terminology, venipuncture, and clinical practice. Graduates may find employment as phlebotomy technicians in various medical facilities or related areas. Salaries are approximately \$34,200 per year.
