

Precision Manufacturing and Maintenance Degree (PMA3)- 60 Credit Hours Customized Training Specialization

Program Description:

The Precision Manufacturing and Maintenance associate degree program is designed to develop versatile skills required for a variety of manufacturing positions, with emphasis on diagnosing and maintaining complex integrated systems. The planned sequence of courses prepares students to install, program, operate, maintain, service, and diagnose electromechanical equipment and produce precision parts used in manufacturing applications. Graduates may find entry-level employment as industrial/mechanical maintenance technicians, automation technicians, flexible manufacturing technicians, robotics technicians, or as supervisors in a variety of settings that require automated manufacturing skills. Initial salaries are estimated to begin at \$48,180. (BLS.gov May 2022).
