Admission Criteria for Registered Nursing (NU43)

Admission to West Georgia Technical College's Health Sciences and Nursing diploma and degree programs is based on a competitive selection process. There are minimum requirements for admission to individual Health Sciences and Nursing programs, and meeting minimum requirements does not guarantee admission to the program.

Non-Georgia residents shall be enrolled on a space-available basis and shall not displace any student desiring to enroll who is a resident of the state. This applies to programs with limited seating, such as competitive selection Health Sciences and Nursing programs and programs that have a waiting list. Please refer to the In-State Residency section of the catalog for more information regarding residency status.

Competitive Selection Deadlines

- The RN program will admit once each year at the Coweta Campus, the Murphy Campus, and the LaGrange Campus.
 - Coweta Campus February 1st deadline for Summer semester cohort start date
 - o Murphy Campus June 1st deadline for Fall semester cohort start date
 - LaGrange Campus September 1st deadline for Spring semester cohort start date

Competitive Selection Requirements

- Must be admitted to the college in good academic standing and regular status.
- Non-Georgia residents will be considered in the competitive selection process on a space available basis.
- Must complete the seven (7) required courses and labs with a minimum grade of "C" or higher and have at least a 3.2 competitive GPA (40% of the process).
 - o ENGL 1101, PSYC 1101, MATH 1111, BIOL 2113, BIOL 2113L, BIOL 2114, and BIOL 2114L are used to calculate the competitive GPA.

- o BIOL courses must be completed within seven (7) years of the program/cohort start date.
- Must complete the Test of Essential Academic Skills (TEAS) exam with a minimum Adjusted Individual Total Score of 75% **and** an Individual Score of 65% in each subject (60% of process).
 - Applicant must earn an Individual Score of 65% on each of the Individual exams to include: Reading, Math,
 Science, English and Language Usage.
 - TEAS Exam must be current within two (2) years of the program start date; maximum of three (3) attempts allowed per calendar year minimum of fourteen (14) days required between testing dates.
 - A copy of the highest earned TEAS Score Report must be attached to the Competitive Selection File Review Request Form. <u>WGTC will accept the highest TEAS score</u>.
 - Students may schedule the exam through WGTC Community Education.
- Must possess a current CPR certification through the American Heart Association for Healthcare Providers-BLS (Basic Life Support).
 - A copy of current CPR certification must be attached to the Competitive Selection File Review Request Form.
 - Online CPR certification will not be accepted.
- Applicant must possess a current State Certified Nursing Assistant Certification (CNA), be a Licensed Practical Nurse (LPN), or present one of the following certifications: EMT/Paramedic, Certified Medical Assistant (CMA), or Surgical Tech
 - The certification or license must have been obtained within the last five (5) years.
 - A copy of the certification or license must be attached to the Competitive Selection File Review Request form.
 - If the certification or licensure was obtained more than five (5) years ago, documentation of a minimum of one (1) year of employment as a CNA, LPN, EMT/Paramedic, CMA, or Surgical Tech within the last five (5) years must be provided.
 - An employer letter of verification must be submitted on company letterhead and include the dates of employment, job title, and a brief description of duties."
- Healthcare Management Degree students may complete NAST 2100 to sit for state CNA license.

Possible Bonus Points: (Maximum of 3 points)

- One (1) point for six (6) months of clinical work experience.
 - Clinical experience is defined as "actual patient care that includes the delivery of physical care such as
 certified nursing assistant, nurse aide, licensed practical nurse, patient care technician, medical assistant,
 surgical technician, back office worker in a clinic or physician's office, or emergency medical technician."
 - Submit an employer letter on company letterhead, include dates of employment, job title, and a brief description of duties for consideration.
- One (1) point for completion of the Nurse Aide Accelerated Certificate or Nurse Aide Certificate.
- Two (2) points for current Licensed Practical Nurses (LPN).

Competitive Selection Process

- 1. Must attend Mandatory Information session with WGTC Advising Coach.
- 2. Gather all supporting documentation including copies of current CPR card, TEAS Exam score, and current CNA certification or LPN license and save electronically.
- 3. Complete <u>Competitive Selection File Review Request Form</u> and attach all supporting documents electronically on or before the deadline (direct questions related to the form to <u>admissions@westgatech.edu</u>).
- Monitor student email and review competitive selection scoring sheet (this does not indicate acceptance or denial).
- 5. Allow 4-6 weeks from the program deadline date to receive acceptance or denial letter from the Admissions Office.
 - > If accepted, respond to secure your seat in the program by the given deadline.
 - ➤ If denied, meet with an Advising Coach to determine next steps. Students not selected into the program cohort must submit a new Competitive Selection File Review Request Form and required documentation to be included in the next selection process for the same program or the selection process for another program
