

# TCSG Clery Act Compliance College Team Activity Guide<sup>+</sup>

## January

### Suggested Team Actions

- Clery Act Crimes
  - Review records of Clery Act crime reports & disciplinary referrals\* for previous calendar year
  - Complete audit trail of all Clery Act crime reports & disciplinary referrals\* including sources other than College Police for previous calendar year
  - Send requests for Clery Act crime reports & disciplinary referrals\* to all Campus Security Authorities (CSAs) for previous calendar year
  - Send requests to external law enforcement agencies requesting Clery Act crime reports for all on-campus, public property & noncampus geography (study abroad, short stays away & repeated use locations) for previous calendar year
  - Review Clery Act fire statistics for on-campus student housing facilities for previous calendar year
- Campus Security Authorities (CSAs)
  - Update CSA directory for new calendar year
  - Archive CSA directory for previous calendar year
- Clery Act Geography
  - Update College Building & Property Inventory
  - Examine public property & noncampus geography
  - Assess short stays away, study abroad programs & repeated use locations
  - Update Clery Act maps
- Collect documentation of all TWs & ENs, archive & update log for previous year
- Issue written requests for number/descriptions of emergency “tests”— i.e. drills & exercises coordinated for previous calendar year & update log for previous year

### Suggested Team Meeting Agenda Topics

- College Clery Act Compliance Team Organization
  - Establishing regular meeting schedules
  - Determining representative Team composition, roles & responsibilities (Chair etc.)
  - Generating & archiving Team records (agendas, minutes)
  - On-going training & archiving records of all Team members
  - Appraising “TCSG Clery Act Compliance: College Unit Roles & Responsibilities” document

## February

### Suggested Team Actions

- Review records of Clery Act crime reports & disciplinary referrals\* for previous calendar year
- Complete audit trail for all Crime reports & disciplinary referrals\*
  - Student Code of Conduct records
  - Employee disciplinary referrals\* from Human Resources
  - Title IX student & employee records
  - On-campus Student Residence Facility reports

### Suggested Team Meeting Agenda Topics

- Campus Security Authorities (CSAs)
  - Confirming CSA identification at least twice annually & as indicated periodically
  - Training CSAs
    - Annual training for returning CSAs

- Training for new CSAs
- Provision for “just in time” training for CSAs with episodic Clery Act responsibilities
- Archiving training records & training logs
- Determining CSA College roles & responsibilities
- Collecting Clery Act crime statistics
- Developing, maintaining & managing digital Crime reporting instrument
- Verifying College records retention

## **March**

### **Suggested Team Actions**

- Review current College Drug & Alcohol Abuse Prevention Program (DAAPP) to ensure compliance with Drug-Free Schools & Communities Act (DFSCA)
- Request records review to ensure all Clery Act crime reports are recorded, counted & classified correctly
- Provide audit trail for College Police Department, external law enforcement agencies & student & employee disciplinary records

### **Suggested Team Meeting Agenda Topics**

- Clery Act Geography
  - Developing & updating Clery Act maps
  - Clarifying public property & noncampus College geography
  - Assessing short stays away, study abroad programs & repeated use locations
- On-campus Student Housing Facility Requirements (if applicable)
  - Identifying & training all on-campus student housing staff & resident assistants qualifying as CSAs
  - Reviewing missing persons reporting protocols
  - Assessing Annual Security & Fire Safety Report (ASFSR) & Fire Log

## **April**

### **Suggested Team Actions**

- Address Clery Act/VAWA/Title IX/HEA updates
- Review ED auditing activity & monitor lessons learned
- Examine institutional related procedures & practices (i.e. creating forms & protocols to document & track activities for noncampus written agreements, athletics, student organization travel, etc.)
- Update & promulgate College Notice of Victims’ Rights & Options document

### **Suggested Team Meeting Agenda Topics**

- Classifying Clery Act Crimes
- Assessing state laws/local ordinances for weapons, drug & liquor law violations
- Assessing VAWA offenses (dating violence, domestic violence, sexual assault & stalking)
- Assessing hate crimes & categories of bias
- Determining the unfounding of crimes
- Clarifying confidential reporting
- Describing FERPA, HIPPA, PII implications for Clery Act compliance

## **May**

### **Suggested Team Actions**

- Gather information & update annual logs regarding College educational programs & campaigns, including but not limited to:
  - College safety & security
  - Weapons, drug & alcohol

- Dating violence, domestic violence, sexual assault & stalking
- Re-send request for Clery Act crime reports to all CSAs if indicated
- Re-send written requests to external law enforcement agencies requesting Clery Act crime reports for each campus; public property & noncampus geography as well as short stays away, study abroad programs & repeated use locations if indicated

### **Suggested Team Meeting Agenda Topics**

- Timely Warnings (TWs)
  - Issuing TWs to members of the College community regarding the occurrence of Clery Act crimes
  - Issuing TWs to students & employees in a manner that is timely, that withholds the names of victims as confidential & that will aid in the prevention of similar occurrences
  - Reviewing circumstances for which TWs will be issued & summary documentation of decision processes
  - Verifying individuals & units responsible for issuing TWs & writing content
  - Confirming manner in which TWs will be disseminated
  - Evaluating TWs with respect to Clery Act crime reports to a pastoral &/or professional counselor
- Emergency Notifications
  - Reviewing Emergency Notification requirements
  - Verifying College policies & procedures for issuance, responsible parties for writing content & methods of dissemination

## **June**

### **Suggested Team Actions**

- Assess previous year's ASR or ASFSR
- Prepare & review ASR or ASFSR draft in the following areas:
  - Ensure Clery Act crime statistics & policy statement disclosures published accurately
  - Request written, documented response from each unit, with suggested changes or indication that no changes are necessary
- Gather Clery Act fire statistics & review Fire Log for on-campus student housing facilities
- Ensure accuracy of CHTR posting

### **Suggested Team Meeting Agenda Topics**

- Reviewing required Clery Act policy statements
- Evaluating efficacy of Clery Act Compliance internal administrative control processes

## **July**

### **Suggested Team Actions**

- Update CSA Directory
- Initiate training for all (new & returning) CSAs
- Update College Building & Property Inventory, review public property & noncampus geography

### **Suggested Team Meeting Agenda Topics**

- Confirming CSA identification at least twice annually & as indicated periodically
- Determining CSA College roles & responsibilities

## August

### Suggested Team Actions

- Re-submit request for Clery Act crime reports to all CSAs if indicated
- Re-submit written requests to external law enforcement agencies requesting Clery Act crime reports for previous calendar year for each campus; public property & noncampus geography as well as study abroad, short stays away & repeated use locations if indicated
- Send correspondence to counseling unit encouraging providing client information of the “confidential reporting” options available at College

### Suggested Team Meeting Agenda Topics

- Establishing protocols for Clery Act Crime reporting
- Reviewing records of Clery Act crime reports & disciplinary referrals\* for previous calendar year
- Completing audit trail of all Clery Act crime reports & disciplinary referrals\* including sources other than College Police for previous calendar year

## September/October

### Suggested Team Actions

- Submit Clery Act Crime statistics & Clery Act fire statistics to Department of Education
- Prepare & promulgate distribution of notice of availability of ASR/ASF SR to current students & employees
- Promulgate revised ASR/ASF SR to units responsible for distribution to prospective students & employees
- Publish current ASR/ASF SR & authenticate url link
- Remove previous years’ ASR/ASF SR postings

### Suggested Team Meeting Agenda Topics

- Reviewing past & present Department of Education Clery Act Audit Findings

## November/December

### Suggested Team Actions

- Ensure accuracy of CHTR posting
- Review, document & archive Annual Summary of College Clery Act Compliance Team Actions
- Report out Annual Summary to College Leadership
- Develop & propose College Clery Act Compliance Team Plan for next year(s)

### Suggested Team Meeting Agenda Topics

- Improving College unit collegiality & participation in Clery Act Compliance
- Reviewing past & present Department of Education Clery Act Audit Findings
