- VAWA Offenses:
 - ❖ Domestic Violence
 - ❖ Dating Violence
 - ❖ Stalking

Geographic Boundaries



Clery Geography:

- Campus
- Public Property
- Noncampus
 - ❖ Study abroad, short stays away, repeated use

Title IX Territory:

- Campus
- Off campus

Campus Security Authorities



Who?

- Campus law enforcement unit;
- Employee responsible for campus security (non police);
- Employee/unit identified as place to report crime; &
- Employee with significant responsibility for student and college activities.

“Super” CSAs:

- College Leadership; Title IX Coordinators; Student Affairs, Athletic & Residence Hall Staff members

Title IX Coordinators: Required Roles & Responsibilities



1. Reporter: Clery Crimes, Disciplinary Referrals, Students & Employees
2. Participant: College Clery Act Compliance Team
3. Author: College ASR/ASF SR Title IX Policy Statements
 - Revised Title IX procedures expected
 - Compile revised College policy statements for ASR or ASF SR
