Title IX

- Covered
 - Students
 - Employees

- Reporters
 - Responsible Employees



Campus Security Authorities (CSAs)

- Campus law enforcement unit;
- Employee responsible for campus security (non police);
- Employee or organization identified as place to report crime;
- Employee with significant responsibility for student and campus activities.



Clery Act Crimes Part 1

- "Primary Crimes"
- Murder and Non-negligent Manslaughter
- Manslaughter by Negligence
- Sex Offenses (Rape, Fondling, Incest, Statutory Rape)
- Robbery
- Aggravated Assault
- Burglary
- Motor Vehicle Theft
- Arson



Clery Act Crimes Part 2

- "Weapons, Drug & Alcohol Law Violations"
- Even if not criminally charged or if sanction is applied, must count report of "disciplinary referral"
- Employees, students, public



Clery Act Crimes Part 3

"Hate Crimes"

Part 1 Crimes – Murder and Non Negligent Manslaughter, Sex Offenses, Robbery, Aggravated Assault, Burglary, Motor Vehicle Theft, Arson

PLUS –Larceny-Theft; Simple Assault; Intimidation & Destruction, Damage or Vandalism of Property

BUT ONLY IF – Based upon 1 of these biases:

Race, Gender, Religion, Sexual Orientation, Ethnicity, National Origin, Disability, Gender Identity



Clery Crimes Part 4

"Violence Against Women Act (2013) Crimes"

- Domestic Violence
- Dating Violence
- Stalking (Audit findings + 30%)



Contemplate

- Clery (\$69,733 and counting)
- Federal Financial Aid
- OCR
- Consumer protection
- Negative Press



Unfounding of Crimes

- <u>Unfounded:</u> A Clery Act Crime report is considered unfounded for Clery Act purposes only if sworn or commissioned law enforcement personnel make a formal determination that report is false or baseless.
- Not equivalent to unsubstantiated



Clery Act Reporting

- Annual Security Report (ASR) or Annual Safety & Fire Safety Report (ASFSR)
- Clery Act Timely Warnings & Emergency Notifications
- TCSG Monthly Weapons Incidents Report
- TCSG Monthly Sex Offenses Report
- Behavioral Intervention Team Monthly Report
- Disciplinary Referrals & internal audits (students & employees)



Clery Geography

- On Campus owned/controlled by College; contiguous & supports institutional purpose;
- <u>Public Property</u> within, immediately adjacent to, accessible from campus;
- Noncampus (vs Off Campus)
 - Owned/controlled by College or officially recognized College organization; frequently used by students; not contiguous; supports institutional purpose
 - Study Abroad, short stays away, repeated use locations



College Educational Training

- Primary, as well as on-going preventative & awareness educational programs & campaigns
- Incoming, Annual & Just in time CSA training
- Bystander Intervention



Clery Act Policy Statements

- 116; almost half added with VAWA reauthorization 2013
- Programs to prevent dating violence, domestic violence, sexual assault & stalking
- Procedures followed when Clery Act crimes reported
