HOW DO I APPLY?


- 1 Complete Dual Enrollment Application

WHAT DOES IT COST?

- Costs vary by program. Charges are assessed by the credit hour.
 - In-state tuition → \$100 per credit hour
 - Out-of-state tuition → \$200 per credit hour
 - International tuition → \$400 per credit hour
- Approximately \$361 in fees each semester
 - Some courses may require additional fees
