



**Accelerated Career** pathways offer qualified Georgia Public High School students a unique path to high school graduation. Students choose to simultaneously earn a high school diploma and a college Associate of Applied Science Degree (AAS), Technical Diploma, a Technical Certificate of Credit (TCC) that leads to State Licensure, or two (2) Technical Certificates of Credit (TCC's) in one of Georgia's high demand fields. Some of the required high school courses may be taken under the state-funded Dual Enrollment Program. Students pursuing Accelerated Career are eligible for ACE Grant Funding and must be enrolled in a TCSG institution.
